You should read daily and practise times tables as much as possible. Don't forget to learn the inverse too e.g. $5 \times 6 = 30$ so I know $30 \div 6 = 5$ and $30 \div 5 = 6$ You should also be practising words from the Year 5 and 6 word list.</p>			
<p>MUSIC In Ancient Benin, music and song entertained the Oba. Can you create an African inspired musical instrument from recycling/recycled objects?</p>	<p>ART Find out about art from Ancient Benin – recreate your own version of your favourite piece. You can draw, paint, make a model of it from clay or use your own ideas. You could also draw a detailed sketch of your favourite Benin Bronze.</p>	<p>DESIGN Find out about the Oba and his palace. Challenge yourself to make a model of the palace or to paint a picture of it.</p>	<p>ART Draw a detailed sketch of a Benin mask. Or, make a model of a Benin mask.</p>	<p>FACTFILE Create a written report about Ancient Benin with subheadings. Show all the important information that you can find (population, culture and pastimes, trade, geography, fashion, rulers, food are some ideas)</p>
<p>NON-CHRONOLOGICAL Using all your knowledge about Ancient Benin, write a report about it. Illustrate your report. You can also choose to make a PowerPoint or a poster.</p>	<p>STORY OR DIARY Imagine that you live in Ancient Benin. Decide who you are- for example, the Oba or a skilled metalworker. Write a story or a diary entry about your life.</p>	<p>COUNTRIES How many countries are there in Africa today? List them alphabetically. Challenge- can you draw some of the flags?</p>	<p>ANIMALS Animals were important in Beninese art. Choose two, draw them and explain why they were important.</p>	<p>BRONZE Do you think that the Benin Bronzes which are held in museums around the world should be returned to Africa? Write a persuasive argument to support your point of view.</p>
<p>RESEARCH What can you find out about the great wall of Benin? Choose how to present your research- for example, a picture, a poster, a model or a PowerPoint.</p>	<p>BRONZES What are the Benin Bronzes? Do some research. Make a PowerPoint to show your findings and email it to school.</p>	<p>TOP 10 Create a list of your top 10 facts about any aspect of Ancient Benin.</p>	<p>MAPPING Draw a map of Africa. Use green, yellow and brown to shade regions of jungle, desert and mountains. Include a key.</p>	<p>RESEARCH How did Ancient Benin fall (end)? Write a newspaper report about what happened.</p>
<p>3D SHAPE Create a poster of 3d shapes. Name them and label their properties. E.g. edges, faces and vertices.</p>	<p>ANGLES Create a poster explaining the different types of angles: acute, obtuse and reflex.</p>	<p>ANGLES Draw 8 different angles. Estimate the size and then measure them. Don't forget you need a protractor.</p>	<p>SHAPE Show the difference between regular and irregular polygons. This could be a poster.</p>	<p>AGREE? A square is a rectangle agree or disagree – do some research and prove your answer to me.</p>
